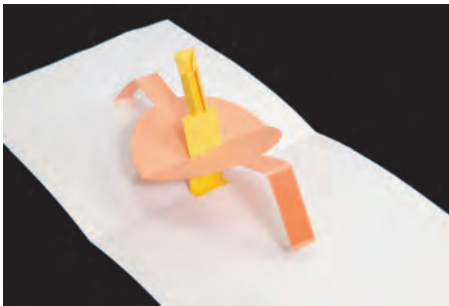


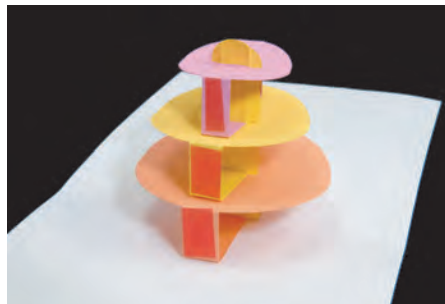
656025 Cake, Three Tier, 3-D



1. Die-cut shapes from material of choice (cardstock recommended). Crease shapes on all score lines. Cut three strips of paper $7/8$ " wide and $10\ 3/8$ ", $8\ 3/8$ ", $5\ 7/8$ " long.



4. Slide the largest Cake tier down the center column until it stops. Then open the set of locking flaps directly above the tier.



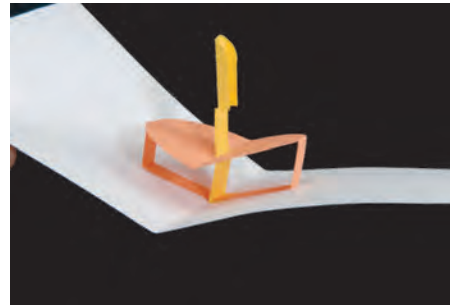
7. Apply adhesive to vertical tabs of each tier on **both** sides of the cake.



10. Repeat steps 8 and 9 with middle and top tiers.



2. Fold in the locking flaps on the sides of the column piece. Align the crease of the bottom flap with the center crease of your card and adhere with strong double-sided tape.



5. Fold both tier end tabs underneath the tier until they touch the center column and adhere.



8. Attach the end of the longest strip ($10\ 3/8$ " x $7/8$ "") to the bottom tier. Place another piece of double-sided tape (no wider than the vertical side piece of the tier) on top of the already-adhered end as shown.



11. Gently fold card closed and apply firm pressure to crease paper strips in the correct position.



3. Apply adhesive to the end tabs on each tier.



6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for the middle and top tiers.



9. Wrap the strip evenly around the bottom tier and adhere the ends together. Ends should have a $1/2$ " overlap.



12. Open the card, and the Cake pops up! Add the preferred Cake topper and embellish.
